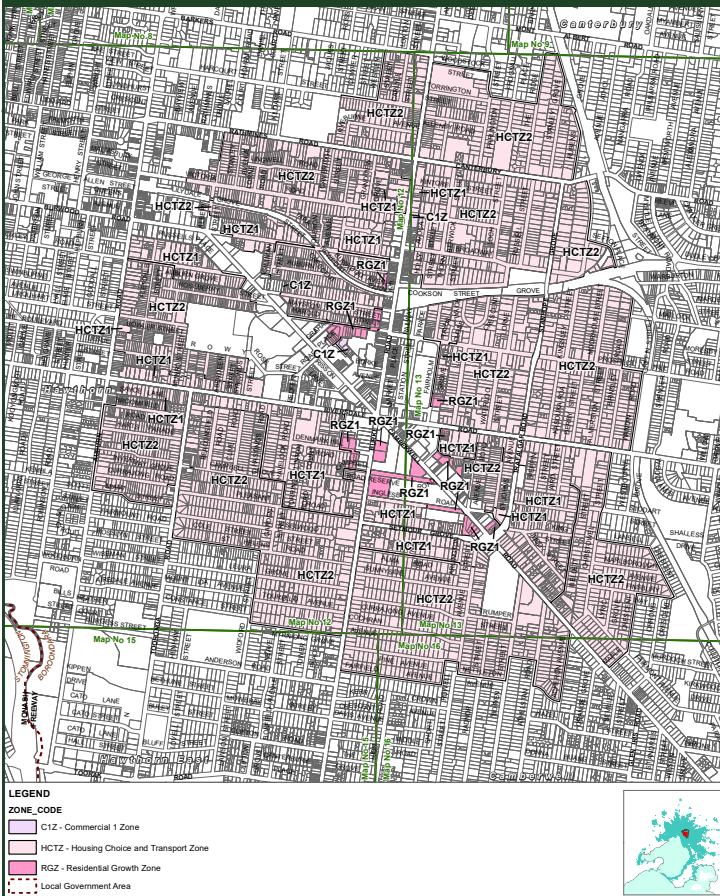
We **AGREE**

- ✓ Boroondara needs more homes, more affordable homes and a greater diversity of homes;
- ✓ Boroondara needs Council-led planning to increase density, not rushed generic State Government Activity Centres that won't deliver affordable housing for young Victorians & families;

- ✗ Removal of appeal rights to VCAT;
- ✗ Planning powers being shifted from local councils to the Minister for Planning.
