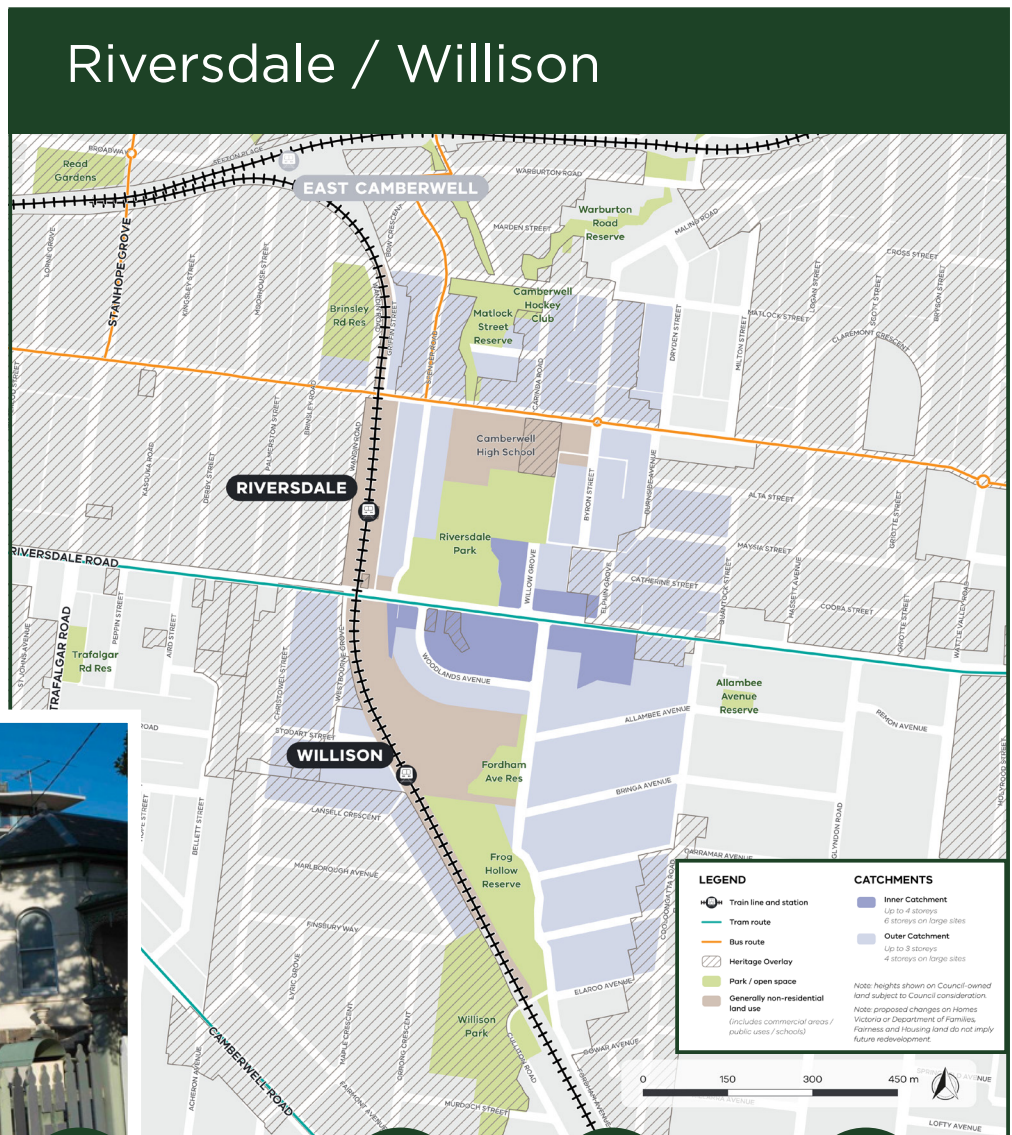




Is your street being rezoned for high-density apartments?

The State Government has released its draft Activity Centre map for Riversdale and Willison. There is no “core” proposed but apartments of up to 6 storeys will be allowed in the “inner catchment” on Riversdale Rd and some adjoining side streets. Up to 4 storey apartments will be permitted in the “outer catchment”. **And yes, this includes heritage protected streets!**

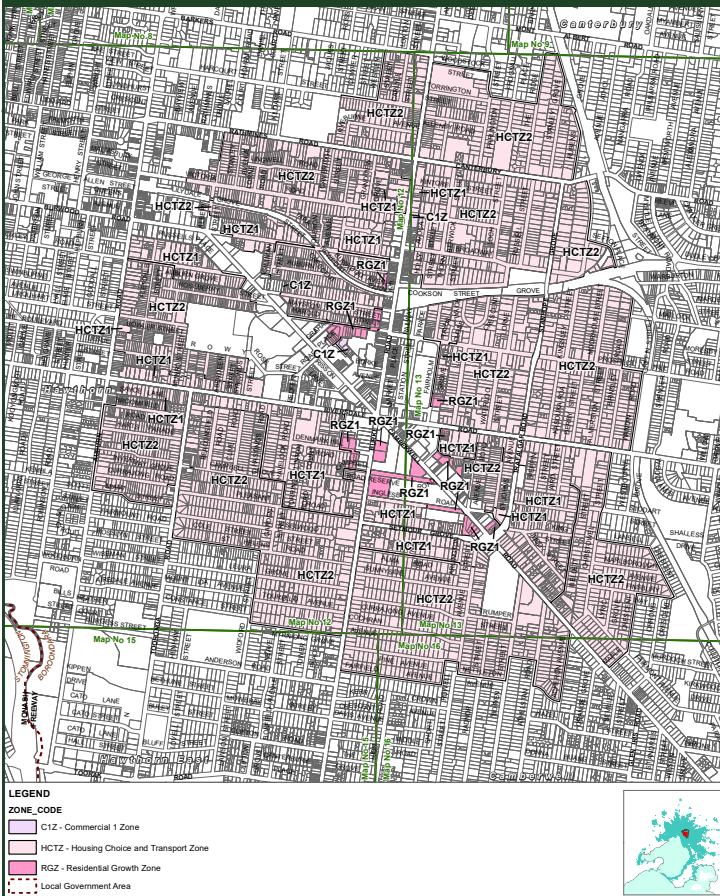
We **AGREE**
